


# Public spending on children and adolescents in Peru (GPNNA)

#### What is GPNNA?

It refers to the allocations of resources made by state in order to improve the living conditions of children and adolescents within the framework of the four guiding principles of the Convention on the Rights of the Child.

Specific spending on children and adolescents (GPE)



#### **Specific GPNNA**

Entire budget of all budgetary programmes, products, projects or activities directly related to children and adolescents.



#### **Articulated Nutrition Programme** (PAN)



Non - specific spending on children and adolescents (GPNE)



proportion of budgetary programmes, products, projects or activities with indirect impact on children and adolescents.





# Main disaggregations in GPNNA calculations

What?

- Function: Education, Health, Social Protection, Sanitation, Transport, etc.
- **Budgetary Programme**: Programme for Learning Achievements in Basic Education (PELA), Articulate Nutrition Programme (PAN), Maternal Neonatal Health Programme, etc.
- Current expenditures: Teaching, health and administrative staff, purchase of goods, other services, etc.
- **Capital expenditures**: Construction of educational, medical, water and sanitation facilities roads, vehicle acquisitions, etc.




- **Spending type:** Specific y Non- Specific.
- Age group: Early Childhood (0 to 5 years), childhood (6 to 11 years) and adolescence (12 to 17 years).
- **PNAIA:** Strategies objectives and results
- Child Rights: Right to Full Development, Right to survival, Right to Protection and Right to Participation.
- Source of financing: Ordinary resources, taxes, duties and royalties, donations and transfers, direct fundraising, others.

# Public spending on children and adolescents as % of GDP





# Total Public Budget and Public Budget for Children and adolescents, 2013-2016


(In millions of soles and annual growth rate)


#### Current expenditure by governmmet level

(In millions of Soles and %)




#### Capital expenditure by government level

Mainly investments projects.


Public Budget for Children and Adolescents and Capital GPNNA by government level and Budget execution, 2016

(In millions of Soles and %)




#### GPNNA by age group in 2016

By 2016, the distribution in the three stages of age group was almost similar.


#### **GPNNA 2016 by age group**







### Lessons learned

1

 Need to strengthen the monitoring role of the GPNNA within the information and monitoring System.

• Need to link the strategic plans, institutional plans and indicators with the budget informations in a single monitoring system( Minimum compatible).

• The results of follow up GPNNA should be disseminated in a timely manner and according to the Budget cycle (Planning, promulgation, implementation and follow up)

• The monitoring of GPNNA allows the awareness of the key actors in order to prioritize children and adolescents throughout the budget cycle.



## Next steps



Expand the diffusion and use of the methodology trough of GPNNA Tracking tools at three national levels



Strengthen the information systems of the institutions in charge of monitoring GPNNA and link it with the budget data.



Strengthen the analysis of the quality and equity of GPNNA with rihths approach,.



Need to Strengthen capacities for better delivery resources, especially at subnational levels.



To ensure that the resources allocated are implemented for the benefit of children and adolescents, it is necessary to strengthen the resource management capacities at the three levels of government (National, Regional and Local).

The allocation of resources is not enough. It is necessary to execute these resources with quality!
